Format:

- 1. One (1) Powerpoint. PPT Format (Keynote and Pdf not accepted)
- 2. Do not use gifs, animations, or special effects (Focus on your message)
- 3. Do include the Poster number and location of your poster on your slide
- 4. Do use the following naming convention when saving your slide

Family Name_Given Name_ImmatriculationNumber_Poster Number

E.g., Hufnagel Charles 20 400 600 Poster A-101

The goal:

- 1. Actively stimulate the audience to come view your poster sessions
- 2. Focus attention on the main topic of your research
- 3. Show main findings of your project only—not the complete poster (which will be available in the poster session)

Posters should be standard poster size (A0), portrait only, and printed and ready to hang by Wednesday, June 28, at 12:00 pm (noon/midday).
